FAMILY FOCUS

Good morning, and welcome to Sunset!

What Makes Jesus's Death Unique?

It is estimated that millions of people were killed by Roman crucifixion—including some of the apostles. Many endured the same kind of physical pain that Jesus suffered. So, was it merely the physical agony of the cross that made His death unique?

Don't get me wrong—the cross was a horrible way to die. But it wasn't the physical pain that set Jesus' death apart. If we focus only on His physical suffering, we risk overlooking the very thing that makes His sacrifice truly one-of-a-kind.

So what was it? What made Jesus's crucifixion different from every other? Before the cross, Jesus wrestled with the full weight of what would come. In the Garden of Gethsemane, He spoke of a cup He dreaded drinking. What was in that cup? Why was Jesus, the Son of God, in such deep anguish before His arrest? Was it only the physical suffering He was about to endure, or was there something more? Our text today—**Matthew 26:36-46**—helps us answer that question.
