FAMILY FOCUS

Good morning, and welcome to Sunset! **Psalm 51:10** (CSB) says, "God, create a clean heart for me and renew a steadfast spirit within me." May our worship today cleanse our hearts and renew our spirits for the week ahead!

In our sermon text today, Paul says something that seems odd: "...salvation has come to the Gentiles to make Israel jealous." What is particularly odd about this statement is that Paul seems to think that this jealousy could be a good thing because it could end up leading to the salvation of many Jews. In what way could Israel's jealousy toward the Gentiles end up leading to their acceptance of the gospel? Here's how: Paul envisions many Jewish people seeing the beautiful faith, hope, and love in the lives of Gentile Christians that it causes them to say, "I want what they have. Their relationship with God is so good, and what they have received in Christ is so powerful that I want those blessings in my life."

There is a compelling principle here: Christianity's appeal can be irresistible when we live out our faith as God intends. Why would anyone want to become a Christian if they see us as bitter, critical people? They wouldn't! However, whenever we live lives that reveal things like freedom from sin, love for enemies, and joy in trials, people ought to be attracted to that. May we live compelling lives of faith for the world to see!
