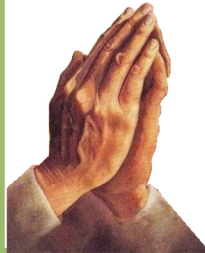

RECENT PRAYER CONCERNS

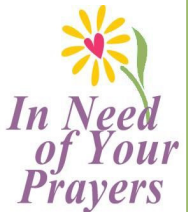
